Is that somebody's name? Aki: No. Soleckshaw is a kind of bike. It means "the Solar-Electric Rickshaw". You know, "rickshaw" comes from a Japanese word. Aki: Really? What is it? Salim: To help the rickshaw driver with his hard work, scientists have produced the Solar-Electric Rickshaw, or Soleckshaw. It's driven partly by pedals and partly by electric power from a . The battery of the Soleckshaw can also be used to charge battery that mobile phones and play an FM radio. Mr. Mori: to get a full charge? Salim: It takes about 8 hours. We can charge it again and again. I see. With that, the rickshaw drivers can easily go up slopes. Yes. Rickshaw drivers will be less tired, work more efficiently, and earn more money. Their Salim: health problems will be reduced, too. Aki: a rickshaw driver, I would want to use the Soleckshaw instead of a rickshaw without the solar power.

Salim: That's right. Especially in busy streets of cities, pollution is at very high levels because cars move very slowly. The Soleckshaw can help to cut down carbon emissions. Maybe, in the

Have you ever heard of 'VR'? It means virtual reality, a kind of computer technology which shows us a virtual world. When I asked this question to one hundred students in this school, many of them answered "Yes." But when I asked them what 'VR' means and how VR is used, \ \(\bar{\pmathbb{1}} \) \ Look at these graphs. We can see that sixty of them knew the meaning of the word. But the number of the students who knew how VR is used was only twenty-five. It's fewer than thirty, half the number of the students who knew the meaning of 'VR'. Today, I'd like to talk about VR as a part of our real lives.

VR changes a lot of things in our lives. For example, the way of playing video games changed when VR was used in them. In video games with VR, we can do many things which we cannot experience in the 2 world. Without VR, we just operate characters in the games. The characters are usually very strong and quick. They run fast, jump high, and fight a lot of enemies. But we are

only sitting in front of a TV or a computer and watching them. In other words, we can (3)

I bought a new video game with VR last month. I was really surprised and excited when I played ait for the first time. We need to wear special goggles to see a virtual world. When I'm playing it, I feel as if I were fighting enemies inside the game. It's really exciting. VR made big changes to the field of video games.


VR is also used in many other ways now. There is a company which developed a VR device for emergency drills. It shows a fire scene, and (5) escape from the fire. With this device,

we can also have practical fire drills without any real fires. Konosu City in Saitama introduced this VR and started to use it for fire drills for the people in the city. I hope other cities start using it for emergency drills soon, too. I also want to try doing a fire drill with it if I have a chance.


In the medical field, some hospitals have started to use VR devices which show patients' bodies. Doctors can practice for surgery with these devices. 6 devices, doctors can practice many times without worrying about the cost. Thanks to these devices, even young doctors can improve their skills. If more doctors use VR for practicing, they

may be able to have more success with some difficult surgeries. This may save many people suffering from serious diseases. I hear that these VR devices will be colleges, too.


